1. Apprentices need a Master/Teacher

- Jesus is our teacher through the Spirit and the Word in the context of the Church.

2. Apprentices Practice

- What inspires us to become an apprentice is initially out of reach so we do well to avoid heroic expectations and instead engage a "one step at a time" life of following Jesus.
- Practices include: **Serving, Worshipping, Learning, Belonging & Sharing.**
