Gospel Imagineers are those who have said yes to Jesus' call "Come follow me." (Mk 2:14) There are four key roles as we follow Jesus: Apprentice, Pilgrim, Story-teller, and Friend. Today we are going to 'imagineer' what it means to be a Story-Teller following Jesus.

1. We are all story-tellers

- a. Our stories are both small and big.
- b. Our stories shape us.

2. **God is a story-teller**

a. God interrupts our story with new stories.

3. Story-Tellers share their new story

- a. How is your God-story unfolding?
- b. These God-stories will stir the imagination of others.
