Original:

Spending of funds is confined to Church approved programs and projects as outlined by the spending plan. Each contribution directed toward an approved program or project will be used as restricted with the understanding that when the need for such a program or project has been met, or cannot be completed for any reason as determined by the Church, the remaining restricted contributions will be used for a similar ministry initiative.

Surplus funds from one budgetary line item or event may be transferred to another budgetary line item or event provided that the transfer of funds does not hinder or harm the budgetary line item or event from which it was taken. Designated funds will not be redirected from their area of designation unless otherwise approved by a church wide vote.

Proposed change:

Spending of funds is confined to Church approved programs and projects as outlined by the spending plan. Each contribution directed toward an approved program or project will be used as restricted with the understanding that when the need for such a program or project has been met, or cannot be completed for any reason as determined by the Ministry leader(s), the remaining restricted contributions will be redirected to another ministry initiative as determined by a team of qualified people under the leadership of the Lead Pastor.

Surplus funds from one budgetary line item or event may be transferred to another budgetary line item or event provided that the transfer of funds does not hinder or harm the budgetary line item or event from which it was taken.
