JKTV Episode 38



This episode's Bible story is from Acts 2:42-47. The Big Idea is: **I can share with my church.** The followers of Jesus remembered what he taught them and tried to live it out. Part of this was sharing with each other what they had. That way everybody had what they needed. What are ways that we can share with our church family? How can this become a way that others see the love of Jesus in our lives?

Activity 1: How Many Ways?

Supplies: (provided) I Can Share sheet, (from home) bag or bowl, scissors

Before Activity: cut out the pictures and place them in a bag or bowl to select from

Talk about it:

- How do you feel when others share with you? Can you think of a time someone shared with you?
- How does it feel to share with others? Can you talk about a time that you shared something?
- Say the Big Idea together: **I can share with my church!**

Instructions:

- Sit in a circle and take turns pulling out a picture from the bag/bowl
- The person who picked the picture starts with one way they can share that item with others. The next person says another way it can be shared. Keep going until everyone has had a turn or there are no more ideas.
- Continue with the next person selecting a picture.
- End by saying the Big Idea together: **I can share with my church!**

Activity 2: Memory Verse Activity "When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIRV)

- Read the memory verse together.
- Ask: Thinking about all of the stories we have been hearing in Acts so far, how did the disciples show they were new in Jesus?
 - What were they doing that was different?
 - How did they live that was different?
 - How are we different because of Jesus?

Activity 3: What Can We Share With Each Other?

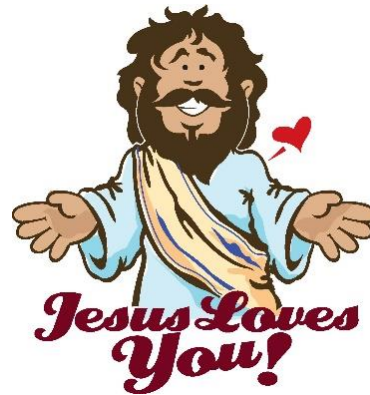
Supplies: (provided) Together activity sheet, (from home) Bible or Bible app, pencil or pen

Parent Tip: Remind your child that the church is people not a building

1. Read Acts 2:42-47 and list all of the different ways the church family shared with each other.

2. How can you share with your church family?

How Many Ways Can I Share?



Instructions:

- Ask your child to look up Acts 4:32-37, helping them as needed, and read it together
- Referring to this passage, ask your child to list all the ways the church family gave to each other in the first section (if they are unable to write, you can write it down for them or they can draw pictures instead).
- Talk about what it would look like to give like this with other people.
- In the second section, ask them to write or draw 2-3 ways they can give to their church family.
- Say the Big Idea together: **I can share with my church!**

Activity 4: Pray together

Parent Tip: Modelling prayer is important. As our children see and hear us pray they will grow in their willingness to pray out loud as well.

- Pray through the items your child wrote down in the last activity. Ask God to help you be willing to share and to practice sharing with your church family.
