### ***THIS WEEK***

- **What were the two types of people today's Bible story talked about?**
- **What can you do to remind yourself to choose wisely and not choose sides?**

### ***REMEMBER THIS***

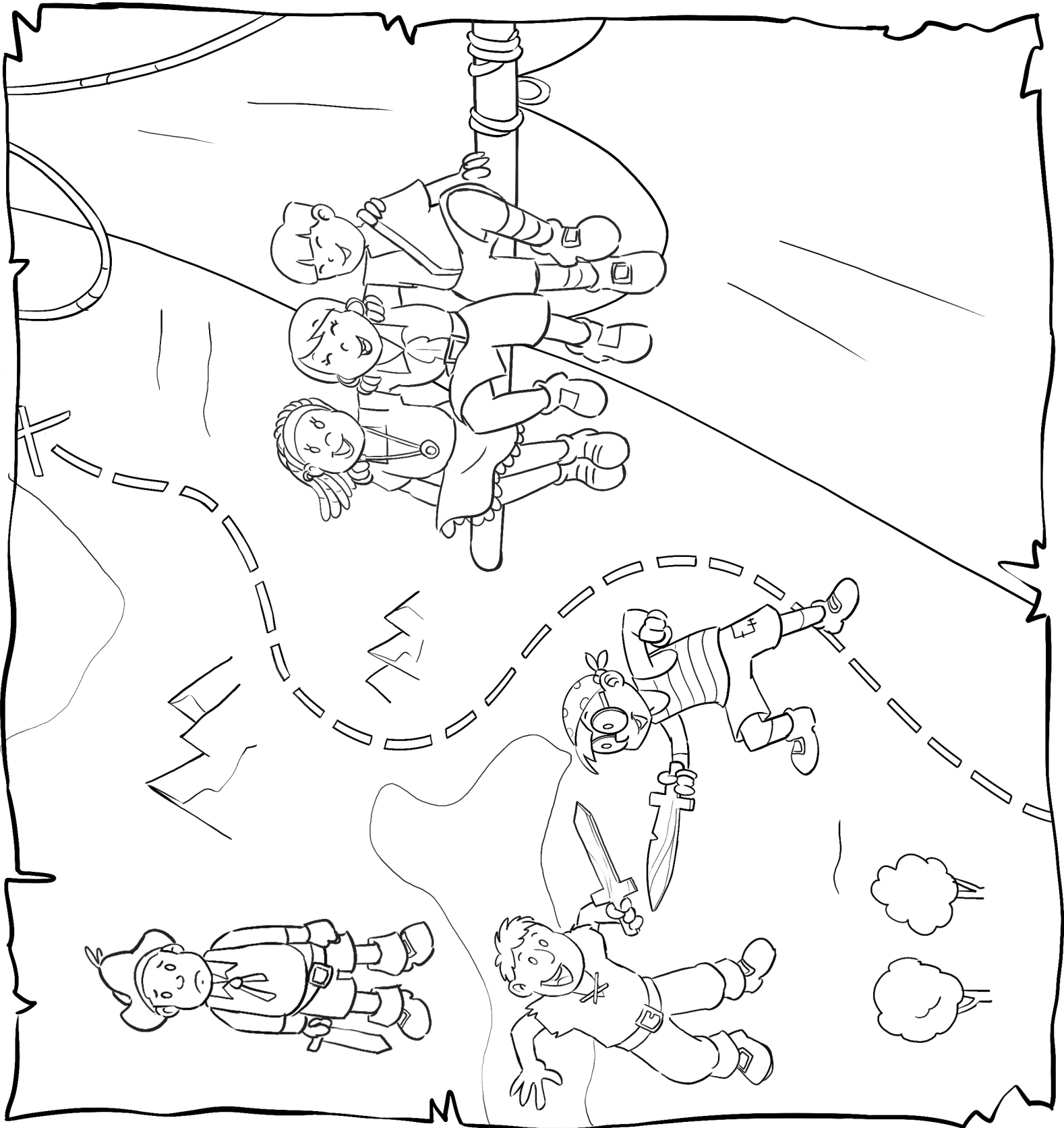
This month, your kids are memorizing the Bible verse **Ephesians 5:15 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them together.
