GROW AT HOME | WEEK 1

THIS WEEK

This week, kids learn that one way to demonstrate **wisdom** is to stay away from **favoritism**.

- THE BIG IDEA: I can be wise by not choosing sides.
- **THE BIBLE:** Proverbs 22:1-2, 8-9, 22-23

ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So ... how was church?"

 What were the two types of people today's Bible story talked about?

REMEMBER THIS

This month, your kids are memorizing the Bible verse **Ephesians 5:15 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them together.

HOW TO MAKE GOLD SLIME

- 1. Place 5 oz. bottle of <u>Elmer's Clear School Glue</u> into a bowl or cup. If you'd like to add water, do so at this point by adding warm water to the empty bottle. Shake the bottle up, and then pour the water into the bowl with the glue.
- 2. Next, add two tablespoons of <u>Colorations Gold</u> <u>Liquid Watercolor</u> to the glue mixture. Stir.
- 3. Slowly add the liquid starch. Pour (about 1/4 cup) of the liquid starch into the glue mixture, then stir very well
- 4. Add half of the remaining liquid starch (about 1/8 cup) to the mixture and stir well.
- 5. Add the remaining liquid starch and continue mixing.
- 6. Knead the mixture using your hands. After kneading for a minute, check the stickiness and stretchiness of the slime. Knead for another minute if necessary, but don't over-knead.
- 7. If need be, add another tablespoon of liquid starch to the slime and knead for another minute or two.
