THIS WEEK: This week, kids hear about what Peter learned from a he had.

TALK ABOUT IT: Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . how was church?"

- What did Peter see in his vision?
- What can we change to make sure we welcome everyone?

LEARN IT: This month, your kids are memorizing the Bible verse Isaiah 6:8 (NIV). See if your child remembers how to say it (can they do the actions too?).

BONUS ACTIVITY: Good News for Everyone

INSTRUCTIONS: On the printable, have kids think about people that they might not typically talk to about Jesus. Have them write their name or draw a picture of a few of these people. Nowadays, it's really easy for people to get deliveries, whether it's a gift or pizza. We learned today that God can deliver everyone, but it's not always easy to deliver that message, right? Sometimes we don't even know that we are leaving people out. It's important that we pay attention to the things we say and do so that everyone will know that they can have access to Jesus, just like we do!

PRETEEN HACK: Have preteens make an acrostic with the word, "EVERYONE," and ideas on how they can practice inclusivity at home, school, and church.

SPECIAL NEEDS HACK: Write the words of the Big Idea on individual labels and have them stick them on the printable in the correct order.
