#### **THIS WEEK**

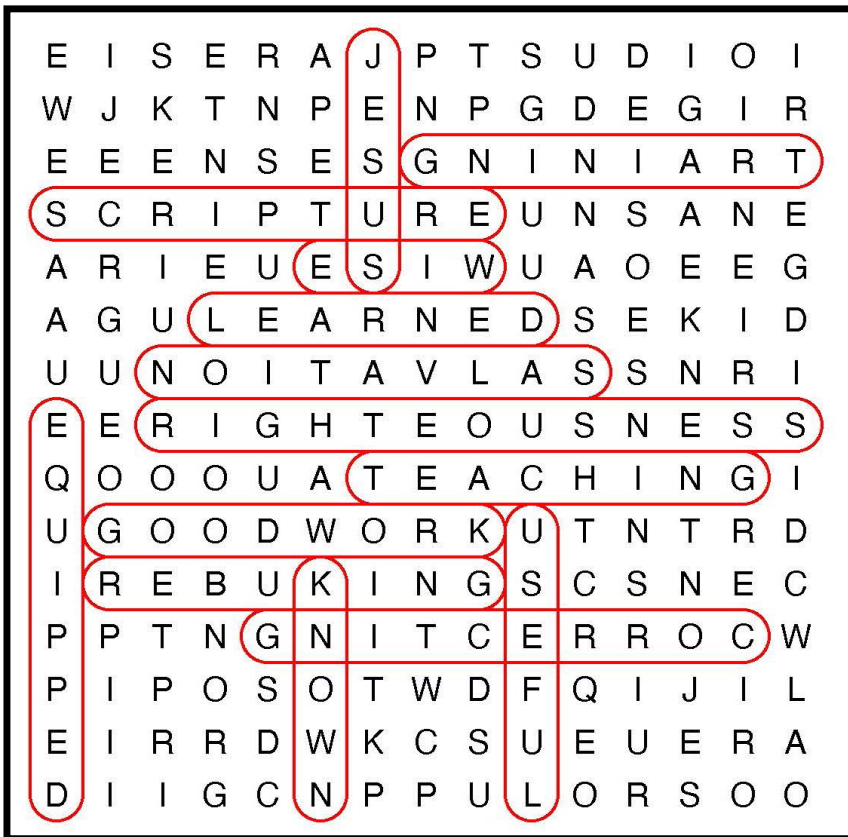
